
We want to partner with organizations in Greensboro working to address systemic health inequities by impacting the social and environmental factors that drive health equity in the following priority areas:

What Will We Fund?

CHF is offering one-time, non-renewable grant support of up to \$10,000 that can be used for:

- Capacity building
- Community building
- General operating expenses
- Program support or development

CHF will distribute up to \$250,000 through this grant process.



Who Can Apply?

Organizations and fiscally-sponsored projects that:

- Have had limited access to funders.
- Are founded, led, and governed by people who reflect the communities they serve.
- Represent place- and/or identity-based communities most adversely impacted by inequitable and discriminatory policies.
- Are pursuing community-powered work that centers racial justice/equity.
- Are nonprofit organizations and/or grassroots groups (with a fiscal sponsor) serving the Greensboro community.
